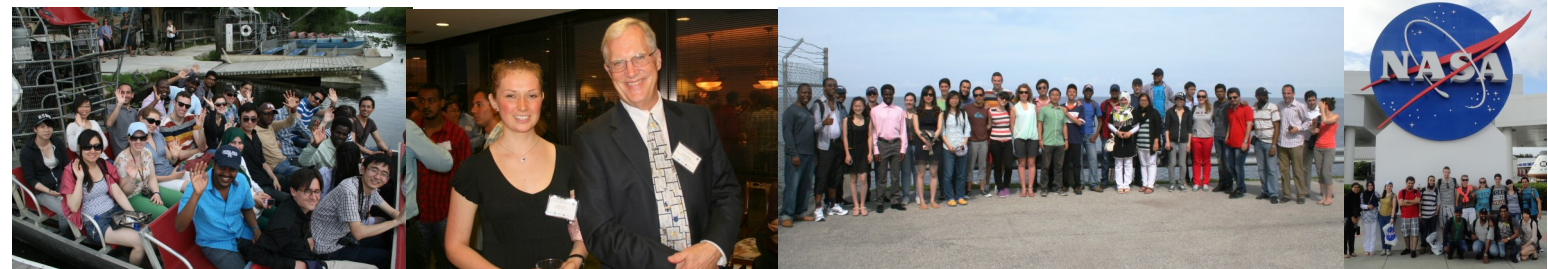

What is the Water Ambassador Program?

- An opportunity for Rotary Clubs to make a real difference in the world by helping students make a difference in developing countries
- MSc Graduate Students from mostly developing countries attend UNESCO-IHE, the Institute for Water Education in Delft, Netherlands
- 32 students from 24 countries come to Florida in May-June with one week of lectures in Delft and two weeks in Florida
- Florida Program teaches them modeling techniques we employ here so they can go back to their home country with this know-how
- Sister program to Rotary International's UNESCO-IHE Water Scholars
- \$1000 sponsorships per student support the Florida Program:
 - Room, board, transportation & venue costs for students while in Florida
 - Expert instructors from Florida to UNESCO-IHE lectures in Delft
 - Rotary events - May 23 in Sarasota area & May 30 in South Florida
 - Your Water Ambassador is from May 1, 2014 until April 30, 2015
