NOW THEREFORE, Foundation and Sponsor agree as follows:

1. Sponsor agrees to sponsor ____ student(s) for the Program beginning May 1, 2014.
2. Sponsor agrees to pay Foundation \$1,000.00 per student for a total of \$ _____. In order to ensure that the Sponsor receives all the benefits described in paragraph 3, payments in full must be received at Foundation’s office on or before April 15, 2014.
3. Foundation agrees to:
 - a. publicize Sponsor’s participation in all promotional materials produced for the Program,
 - b. connect Sponsor and the student(s),
 - c. ensure Sponsor receives regular updates from the sponsored student(s) until April 30, 2015,
 - d. provide sponsor with the opportunity to meet the sponsored students(s), and
 - e. Provide Sponsor with the opportunity to attend welcoming receptions in Tampa and West Palm Beach and other places of opportunity. Foundation agrees to provide Sponsor with students’ agenda while in the US, so that those opportunities can be realized.

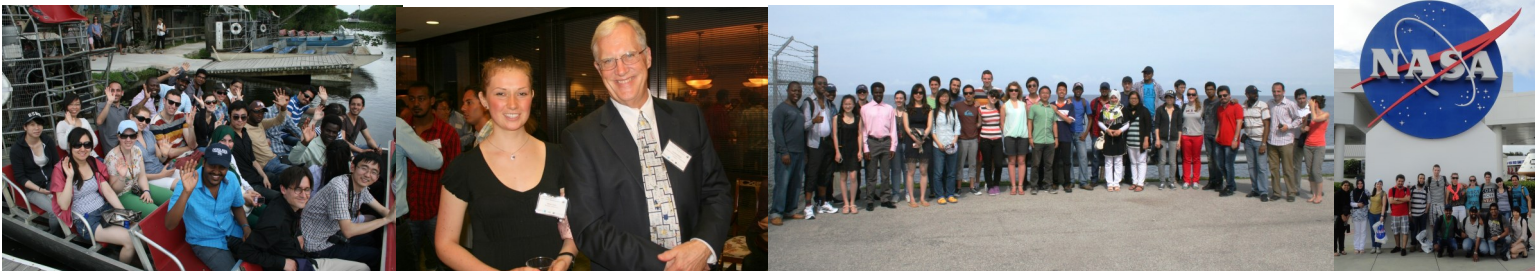

What is the Water Ambassador Program?

- An opportunity for companies, organizations and individuals create an impact in the world by helping students make a difference in developing countries
- MSc Graduate Students from mostly developing countries attend UNESCO-IHE, the Institute for Water Education in Delft, Netherlands
- 32 students from 24 countries come to Florida in May-June with one week of lectures in Delft and two weeks in Florida
- Florida Program teaches them modeling techniques we employ here so they can go back to their home country with this know-how
- \$1000 sponsorships per student support the Florida Program:
 - Room, board, transportation & venue costs for students while in Florida
 - Expert instructors from Florida to UNESCO-IHE lectures in Delft
 - Rotary events - May 23 in Sarasota area & May 30 in South Florida
 - Your Water Ambassador is from May 1, 2014 until April 30, 2015. Sponsors may post their Ambassador onto media during the that time as a way of highlighting the sponsorship and establish a one-on-relationship with the student
