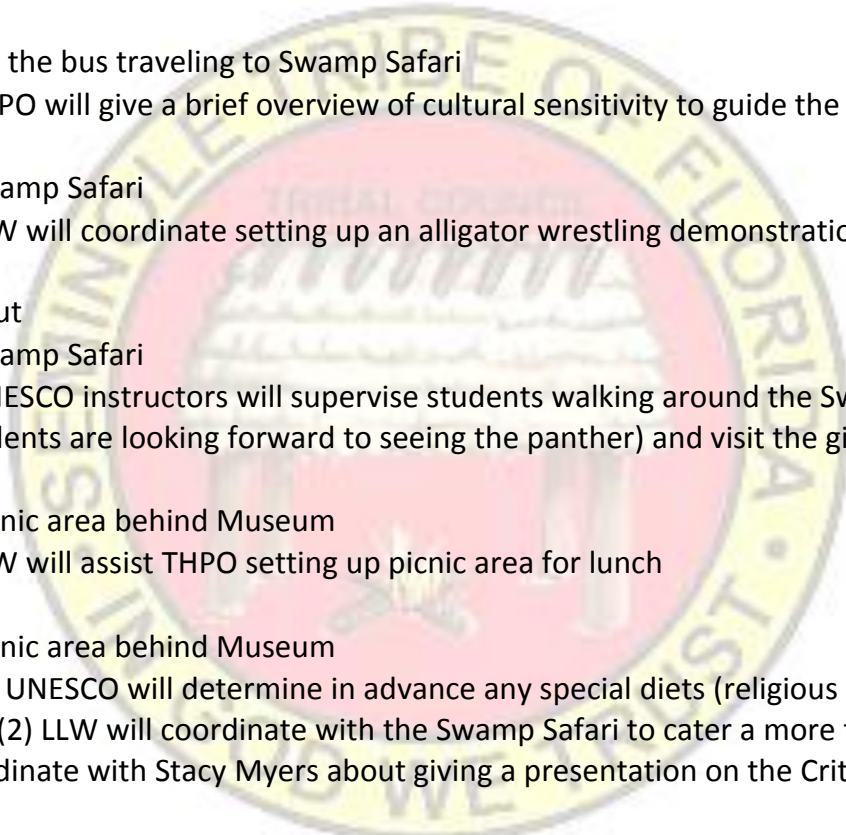


MAY 22, 2015 UNESCO-BIG CYPRESS SEMINOLE INDIAN RESERVATION EVENT

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- 9:30-9:45 Seminole Tribe of Florida official welcome
- Location: Meet at Museum for Tribal representative welcoming
 - Logistics: THPO will coordinate with Tribal Council and set up
- 9:45-10:00 Sensitivity overview
- Location: On the bus traveling to Swamp Safari
 - Logistics: THPO will give a brief overview of cultural sensitivity to guide the UNESCO group throughout the day
- 10:00-12:30 Swamp Safari Tour
- Location: Swamp Safari
 - Logistics: LLW will coordinate setting up an alligator wrestling demonstration, air boat tour, and swamp buggy tour

 - Logistics: UNESCO instructors will supervise students walking around the Swamp Safari to view the critter exhibits (the students are looking forward to seeing the panther) and visit the gift shop

 - Logistics: LLW will assist THPO setting up picnic area for lunch
